# ADOPTION STATEMENT

SITE ALLOCATIONS DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT, and,  
CORE STRATEGY POLICY HO9  
(CONVERSION & RE-USE OF RURAL BUILDINGS AS DWELLINGS)



The above documents were adopted at the North Norfolk District Council Full Council Committee Meeting on 23 February 2011.

The **Site Allocations** document allocates land for new housing, employment and other uses in a number of towns and villages across North Norfolk.

The **Conversion and Re-Use of Rural Buildings as Dwellings Policy** outlines the circumstances in which rural buildings can be used as permanent homes.

The **Proposals Map** illustrates the allocated sites plus new and existing policy areas on an Ordnance Survey map base. This map will be updated in due course.

Any person aggrieved by the Site Allocations DPD or Core Strategy Policy HO9 may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that a) the document is not within the appropriate power; b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with. An application must be made not later than Wednesday 6 April 2011.
