## How do I register to vote?

Fill in this form (electoral registration form). Make sure **you** sign the 'declaration'. Return your completed form as soon as possible to: **Electoral Services, North Norfolk District Council, Holt Road, Cromer, NR27 9EN**. You are **not** automatically registered, even if you pay Council Tax.

## Who can register to vote?

Anyone aged 16 or over (but you cannot vote until you are 18).

British or Commonwealth citizens, Citizens of the Republic of Ireland or other European Union (EU) countries. Citizens of EU countries (other than the UK, Ireland, Cyprus, Malta) cannot vote in UK Parliamentary elections and must fill in a separate form to vote in European Parliamentary elections.

You can only apply for registration at your current home. There are some exceptions e.g. students. You can apply at your temporary home if you currently have no other home. If this property is your second home you need to reside here for at least 6 months of a year and not rent out at other times. If you have any questions regarding your residency please contact Electoral Services on the number(s) above.

## What is the electoral register?

The electoral register is the list of everyone who is registered to vote. You must be on the register to vote in elections and referendums. You can register to vote at any time. If you're not registered, for example, if you have moved home, you need to fill in a registration form.

## Who has my personal details?

There are two versions of the register – the **full** version and the **edited** version. Your details will appear on the full version of the register, but you can **choose** whether or not your details appear on the edited register.

The full register is used for elections and referendums, preventing and detecting crime and checking applications for credit. The edited register is available for general sale and can be used for commercial activities such as marketing. You can tick the box overleaf if you do not want your details to appear on the edited register or leave the box blank if you wish to be included.

## When will my application be added to the electoral register?

If your application is valid and not subject to any objections we will write to tell you when you will be added to the electoral register. If you return this form by the dates shown below we will endeavour to add you to the next available register.

During September, October or November (the annual canvass period) all households have to register, you will receive a household Voter Registration form delivered to your property which must also be completed and returned. During election periods, if your registration form is received 11 working days before polling day - and no objection is made - you will be eligible to vote in that election. However, your details will only be published on the electoral register from the beginning of the month following polling day.
