Project Overview

February 2024

Balfour Beatty are delighted to begin works on the Cromer & Mundesley Coastal Management Scheme, procured through SCAPE. These essential works are being delivered by Coastal Partnership East on behalf of North Norfolk District Council and are being funded by the Environment Agency, Anglian Water, NNDC and Mundesley Parish Council. The Scheme will protect 600 local homes and businesses from flooding and coastal erosion.

Overview of project works are as follows:

Cromer Coastal Defence Scheme:

These works involve the construction of a new rock armour revetment on the Norfolk coast west side of Cromer pier, with 38,000 tonnes of rock placed on the shoreline. It will also include repair and installation works on: groynes; navigation beacons; concrete apron; rock revetment; access improvement works.

Mundesley Coastal Defence Scheme:



This will involve 30,000 tonnes of rock being placed on the shoreline. The team will also reinforce the existing coastal protection infrastructure and refurbish the groynes and navigation beacons. Work will see a rock revetment – used to absorb the energy from the waves - in front of an existing steel frame and will also involve concrete works.



We have been mobilising our site compound in Mundesley in March and Cromer in April.

March 2024

Mobilising site compound in Mundesley & commencement of the concrete works for Frontages along sea front.

April 2024

Continue with the concrete encasement to Frontages. Start Cromer sheet piles and build the Cromer compound setup.

June 2024

Arrival of rock armour from Scotland via Ships.

October 2024

Completion of the rock armour deliveries and the rock placement along the beaches continues through to November.

December 2024

Continue with Concrete works along the Mundesley beach front and completion of Cromer works are achieved.

Monday to Friday 0700-1800

June 2024: Continuous rock deliveries for 3 days, followed by break, then repeat
