 THE LOCAL AUTHORITY (MEMBERS' ALLOWANCES) (ENGLAND)  
 REGULATIONS 2003

North Norfolk District Council has made a scheme of allowances for Councillors. Copies of the scheme are available for inspection during normal opening hours.

With effect from 1 May 2025 to 31 March 2026, the allowances payable under the scheme are as follows: -

A Basic Allowance to all elected Councillors of £6,491.00 pa (to include £180 Broadband Allowance).

Special Responsibility Allowances (a maximum of one per Councillor) payable per annum to the holders of the following positions:

Travel payable for approved duties calculated in accordance with the prevailing national levels for local authority Councillors.

Family and friends' carer's allowance rate: up to £10 per hour.

Higher rate of carer's allowance in exceptional circumstances: authority delegated to the Democratic Services Manager to consider payments for carer's allowance on a case-by-case basis.

Subsistence payments are at the following rates: breakfast - £6.88; lunch - £8.00; dinner - £20.00. Breakfast will only be payable when an overnight stay is required.

There is an option for Councillors not to claim allowances, in part or full.

NOTE: The above Scheme is subject to index-linked increases aligned to the Officers' Scheme when awarded.
