North Norfolk District Council was the first council in Norfolk to recognise challenges of climate change and declared a climate emergency in early 2019. Within the Net Zero Strategy and Action Plan, we aim to work with our residents and businesses to help reduce their emissions through actions they can take, big or small.

Scheme for development within North Norfolk are ask to demonstrate how the proposed development is responding positively to a climate emergency will depend on the proposal but could include demonstrating how design and material choices help make the development more sustainable, energy efficient and reducing harmful effects on the environment.

Evidencing a reduction in the carbon impact of development could include identifying how the proposal represents an improvement over current building regulation requirements (Part L).

Net Zero buildings means reduced embedded carbon from materials and construction. Operationally reducing emissions by having a low-carbon heating technology and renewable energy generation and energy efficiency revolving around reduced heat loss.
