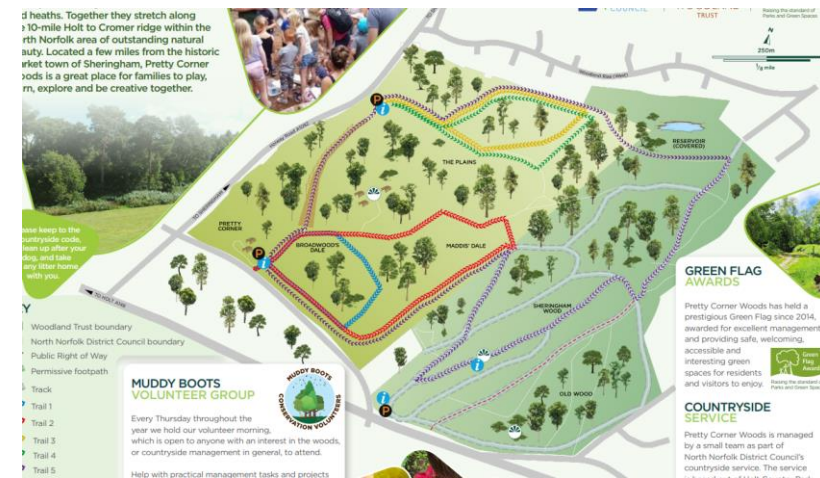

COMPARTMENT AND RIDE NUMBER	YEAR	ACTIVITY/OPERATION
1 (Field) Community nursery	2026 to September 2030	<p>Winter. Refer to tree felling license for tree thinning works for compartment 1. Tree checks and tree felling for health and safety purposes where required. Maintain bird and bat boxes, replace when required. Reduce volume of invasive plants, rhododendron and bracken. A selection of dead wood is to be retained (both standing and lying) as required in the tree felling license. On woodland boundaries plant with native hedge tree species.</p> <p>Spring and Summer Create grassland margins surrounding the field of various heights for wildlife. Protect habitat areas. Sow or plant native wildflower plugs/plant species appropriate to encourage insects. Maintain areas of protect and provide habitat areas for/used by amphibians and reptiles. Survey flora and fauna species. Butterflies, reptiles and amphibians, dragonfly and damselfly, insects, beetles, mammals.</p> <p>Community nursery area. Maintain community nursery throughout the year. Field, amenity grass cutting where required, care must be taken to protect wildlife species and grassland margins which are used by wildlife. Gap up hedge margins where required with native hedge species. A selection of dead wood is to be retained on site (both standing and lying) as required in the tree felling license.</p>
Compartment 2	2026 to 2030	<p>Winter. Refer to tree felling license for compartment 2, tree thinning operations. Tree checks and tree felling for health and safety purposes where required. Maintain bird and bat boxes, replace when required. Reduce volume of invasive plants, rhododendron and bracken. A selection of dead wood is to be retained (both standing and lying) as required in the tree felling license.</p> <p>Spring and Summer Survey flora and fauna species. Butterflies, reptiles and amphibians, dragonfly and damselfly, insects, beetles, mammals.</p>

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		<p>Autumn: Late October. Protect and maintain wildflower rides by reducing regeneration of trees and shrubs where required with the help of muddy boots volunteer group. Sow or plant native wildflower plugs/plant species appropriate to encourage insects.</p> <p>Maintain educational area and create bog/water area for amphibians. Install wildlife interpretation.</p>
Compartment 3	2026 - 2030	<p>Winter: Refer to tree felling license for compartment 3, tree thinning operations.</p> <p>Tree checks and tree felling for health and safety purposes. A selection of dead wood is to be retained (both standing and lying) as required in the tree felling license. Stack dead wood, branches, timber which cannot be used for firewood, as a dead hedge in appropriate areas within the woodland block which makes up the compartment. Maintain bird and bat boxes, replace when required. Reduce volume of invasive plants, rhododendron and bracken. For wildflower rides control regrowth of trees, invasive plants to keep these areas open for wildflowers. Create wildflower glades where appropriate.</p> <p>Spring and Summer Survey flora and fauna species. Butterflies, reptiles and amphibians, dragonfly and damselfly, insects, beetles, mammals.</p> <p>Protect and provide habitat areas for/used by amphibians and reptiles.</p>
Compartment 4. Car park area.	2026-2030	<p>Winter: Refer to tree felling license for compartment 4, tree thinning operations. Tree checks and tree felling for health and safety purposes. Reduce volume of invasive plants, rhododendron and bracken.</p> <p>For wildflower rides control regrowth of trees, invasive plants to keep these areas open for wildflowers. Create wildflower glades where appropriate. Stack dead wood, branches, timber which cannot be used for firewood in appropriate areas within the woodland block which makes up the compartment. A selection of dead wood is to be retained (both standing and lying) as required in the tree felling license.</p> <p>Spring and Summer Survey flora and fauna species. Butterflies, reptiles and amphibians, dragonfly and damselfly, insects, beetles, mammals.</p> <p>Protect and provide habitat areas for/used by amphibians and reptiles.</p> <p>Picnic area, leave areas of wildflower grassland at various heights for wildlife. Maintain wildflower areas.</p> <p>On woodland boundaries plant with native hedge tree species.</p>
Compartment 5.	2026-2030	<p>Winter: Refer to tree felling license for compartment 5, tree thinning operations. Tree checks and tree felling for health and safety purposes. Reduce volume of invasive plants, rhododendron and bracken.</p>

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		<p>For wildflower rides control regrowth of trees, invasive plants to keep these areas open for wildflowers. Create wildflower glades where appropriate. Stack dead wood, branches, timber which cannot be used for firewood in appropriate areas within the woodland block which makes up the compartment. A selection of dead wood is to be retained (both standing and lying) as required in the tree felling license.</p> <p>Plant woodland boundary with native hedge trees.</p> <p>Spring and Summer Survey flora and fauna species. Butterflies, reptiles and amphibians, dragonfly and damselfly, insects, beetles, mammals.</p> <p>Protect and provide habitat areas for/used by amphibians and reptiles.</p>
Compartment 6	2026-2030	<p>Winter: Refer to tree felling license for compartment 6, tree thinning operations. Tree checks and tree felling for health and safety purposes. Reduce volume of invasive plants, rhododendron and bracken.</p> <p>For wildflower rides control regrowth of trees, invasive plants to keep these areas open for wildflowers. Create wildflower glades where appropriate. Stack dead wood, branches, timber which cannot be used for firewood in appropriate areas within the woodland block which makes up the compartment. Stack dead wood, branches, timber which cannot be used for firewood in appropriate areas within the woodland block which makes up the compartment.</p> <p>Spring and Summer Survey flora and fauna species. Butterflies, reptiles and amphibians, dragonfly and damselfly, insects, beetles, mammals.</p> <p>Protect and provide habitat areas for/used by amphibians and reptiles.</p>
Compartment 12	2026-2030	<p>Winter: Refer to tree felling license for compartment 12, create open space for wildlife and wildflower ride</p> <p>Reduce volume of invasive plants, rhododendron and bracken. Stack dead wood, branches, timber which cannot be used for firewood in appropriate areas within the woodland block which makes up the compartment.</p>

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		<p>For wildflower rides control regrowth of trees, invasive plants to keep these areas open for wildflowers.</p> <p>Spring and Summer Survey flora and fauna species.
