

# Wildcraft Brewery / The Farm – Noise Management Statement

## Premises Licence Variation – Supporting Document

This statement outlines how the premises will manage noise to support the prevention of public nuisance, particularly in relation to the extended licensed areas shown on the enclosed site plan.

The premises is located within a rural setting, surrounded by open farmland, with the closest neighbouring residential properties approximately **a quarter of a mile away**. While this provides natural separation, we recognise that sound can travel across open fields and we remain committed to ensuring noise is appropriately controlled at all times.

The site operates primarily as a community, family-friendly venue with planned activities such as farmers markets, camping and education sessions. **No amplified music is proposed as part of this licence variation**, and outdoor bar service is intended to support these activities rather than create a high-intensity or late-night entertainment environment. Outdoor bar points will be **closed by 21:00**, with service thereafter contained within the main brewery tap room until 23:00, allowing supervision and activity to be concentrated in one main area during the final hour of trading.

The premises has previously developed and successfully implemented a more extensive sound management plan for larger-scale events such as Wildfest. Whilst these additional controls are not anticipated to be necessary for the activities proposed under this variation, they demonstrate that the business understands the importance of noise management and has the experience and procedures in place to take proportionate action if required. Staff will continue to monitor noise levels during trading, particularly later in the evening and during outdoor use, and will intervene where necessary to maintain a calm and respectful environment.
