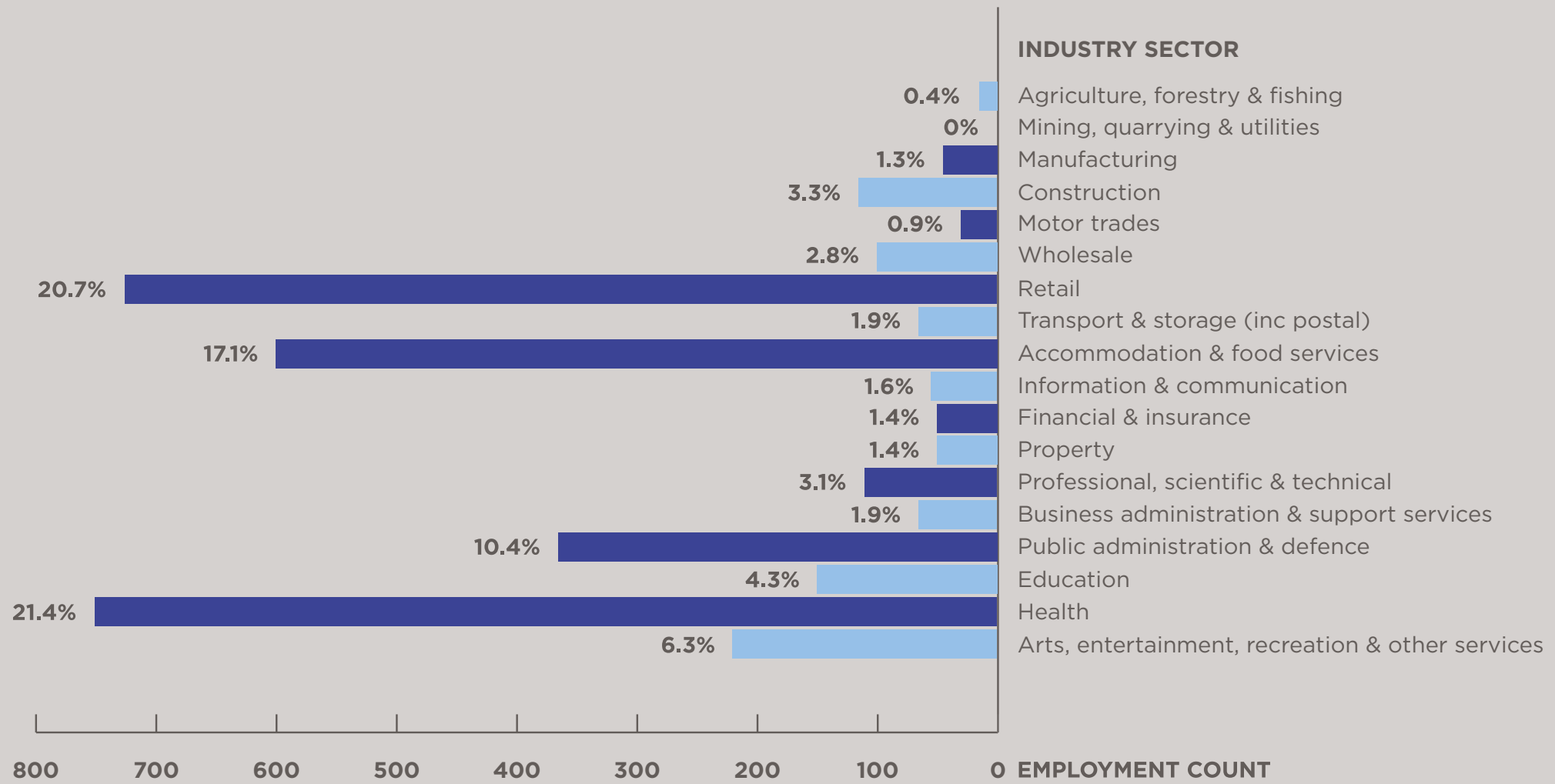




Number of people in employment in Cromer, 2016

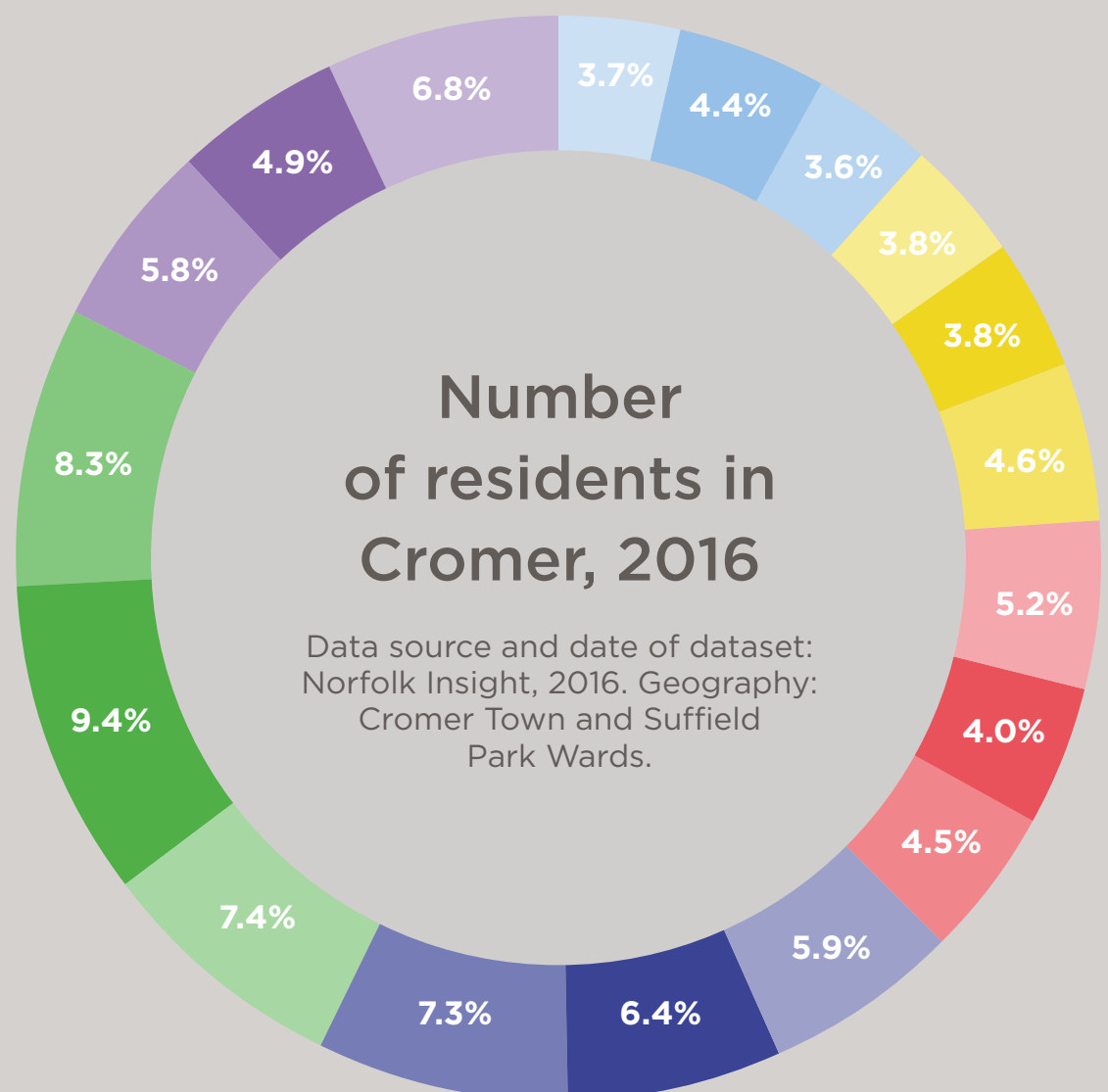

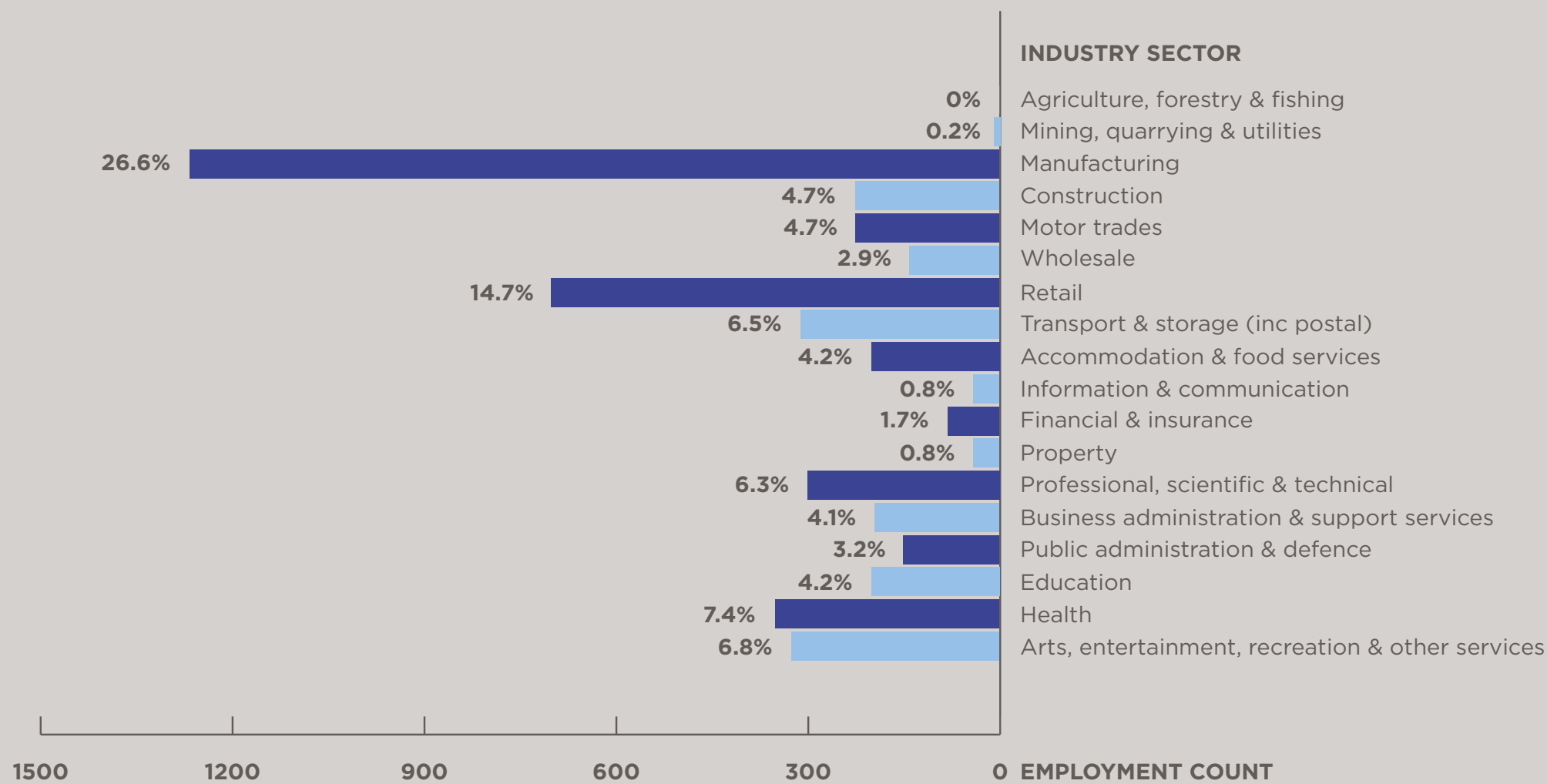

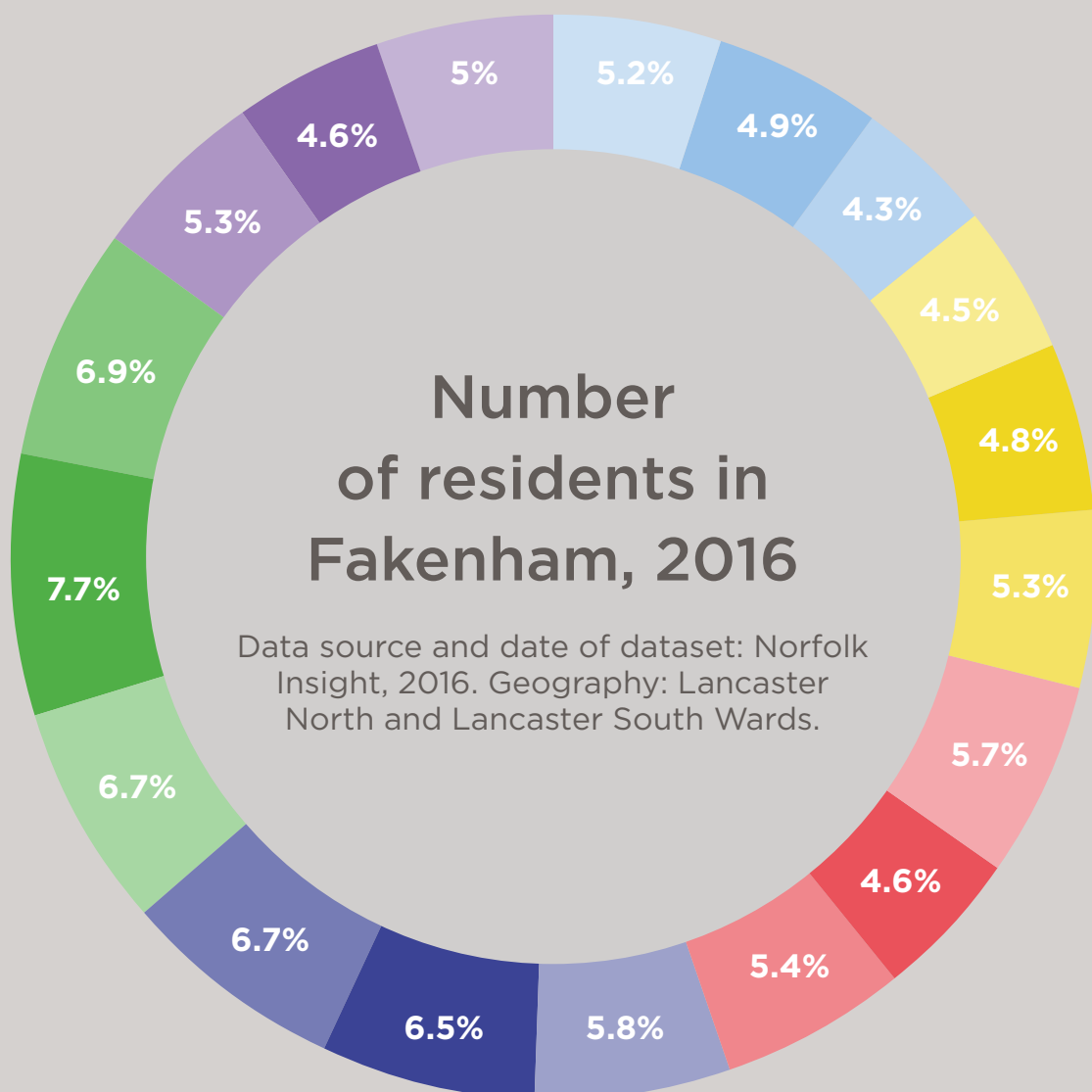

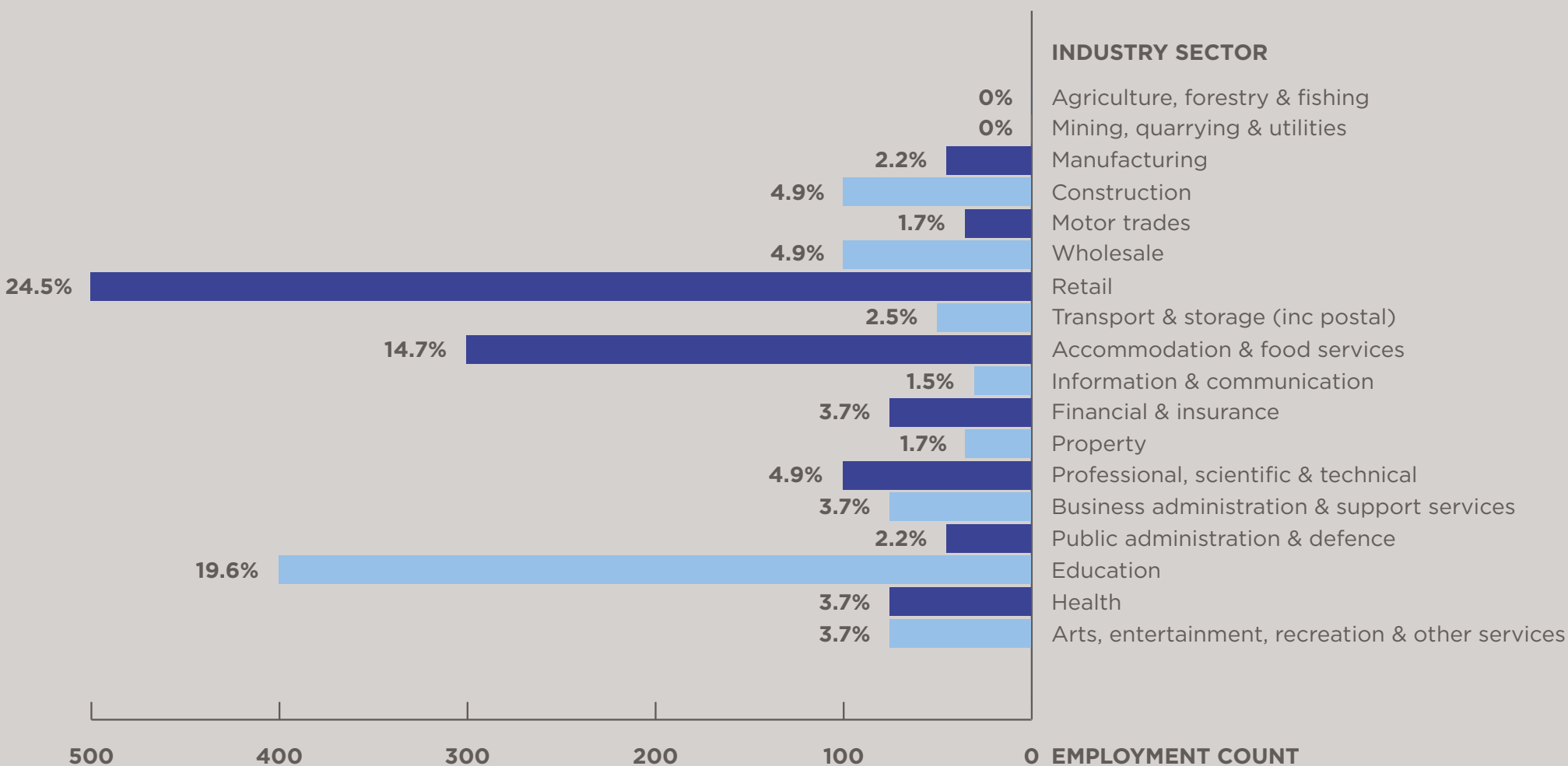

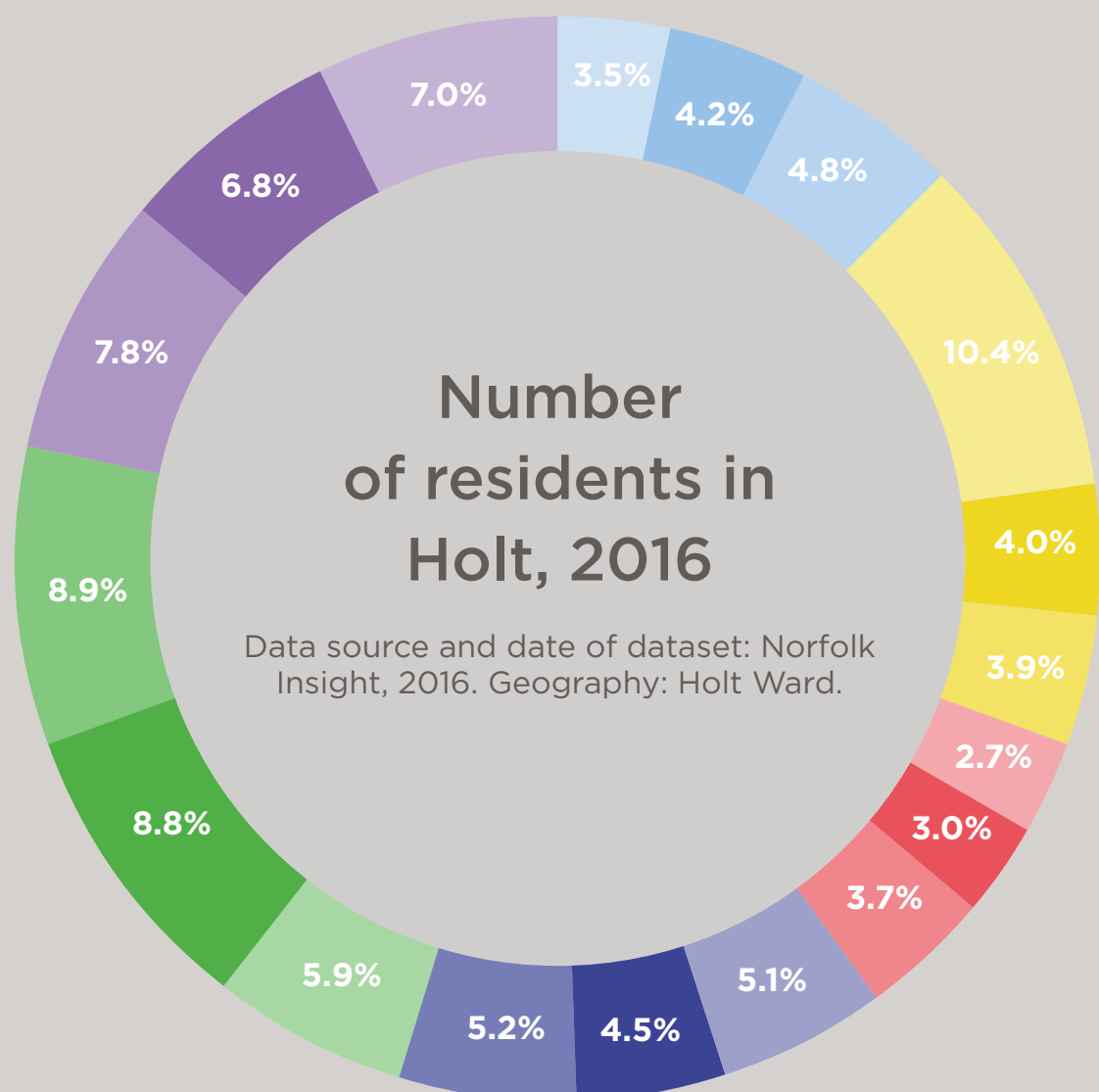

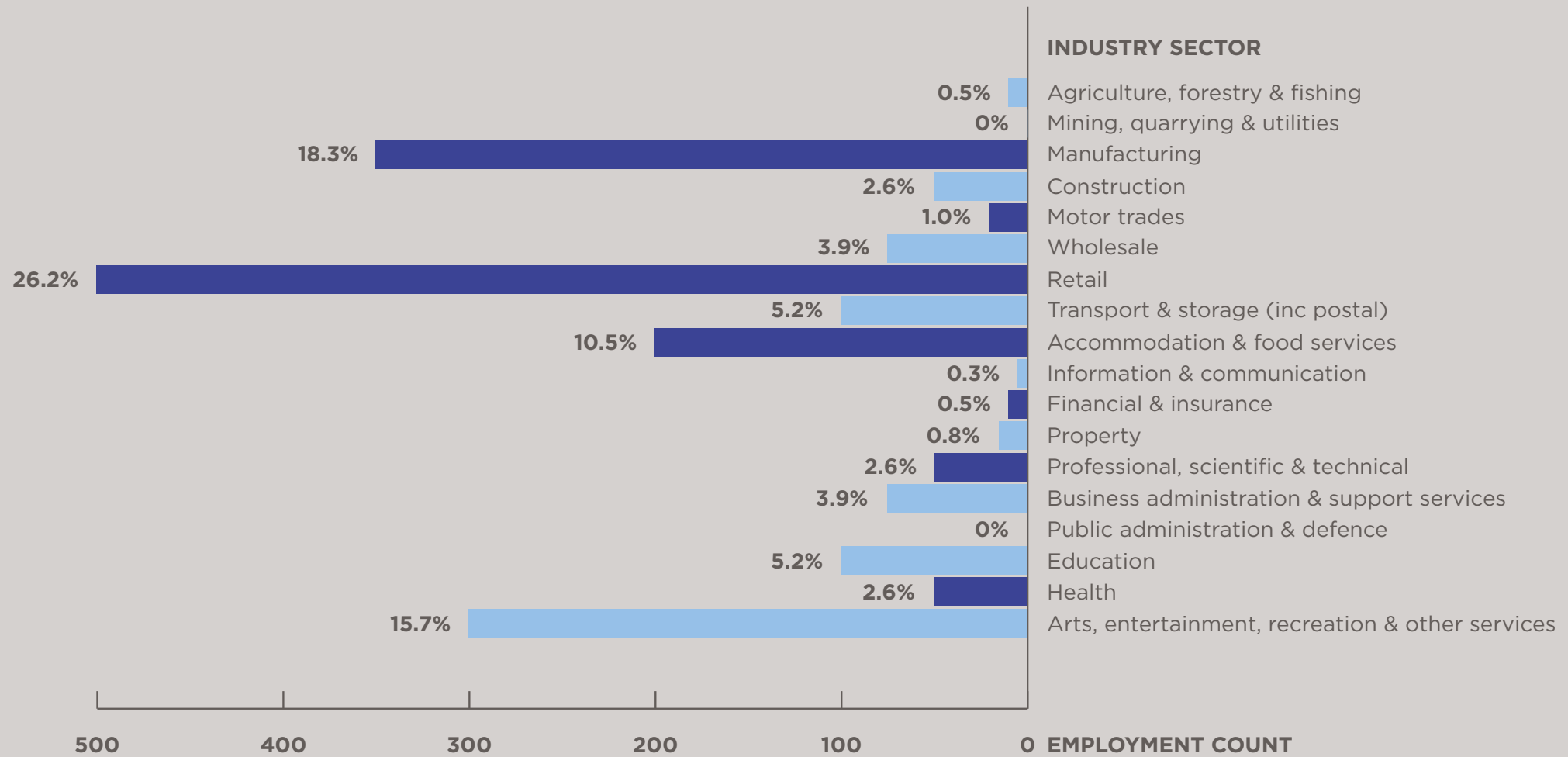

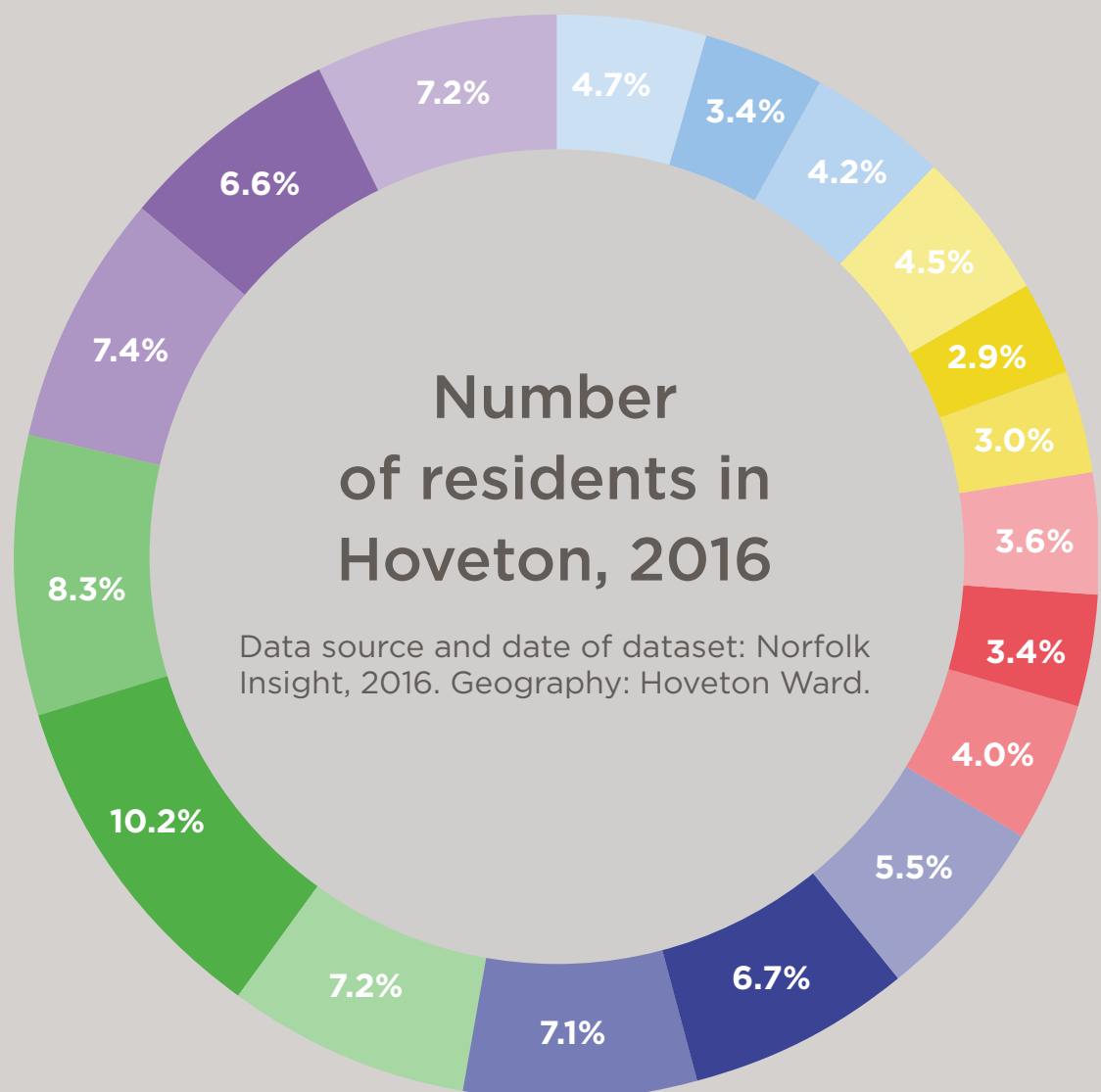

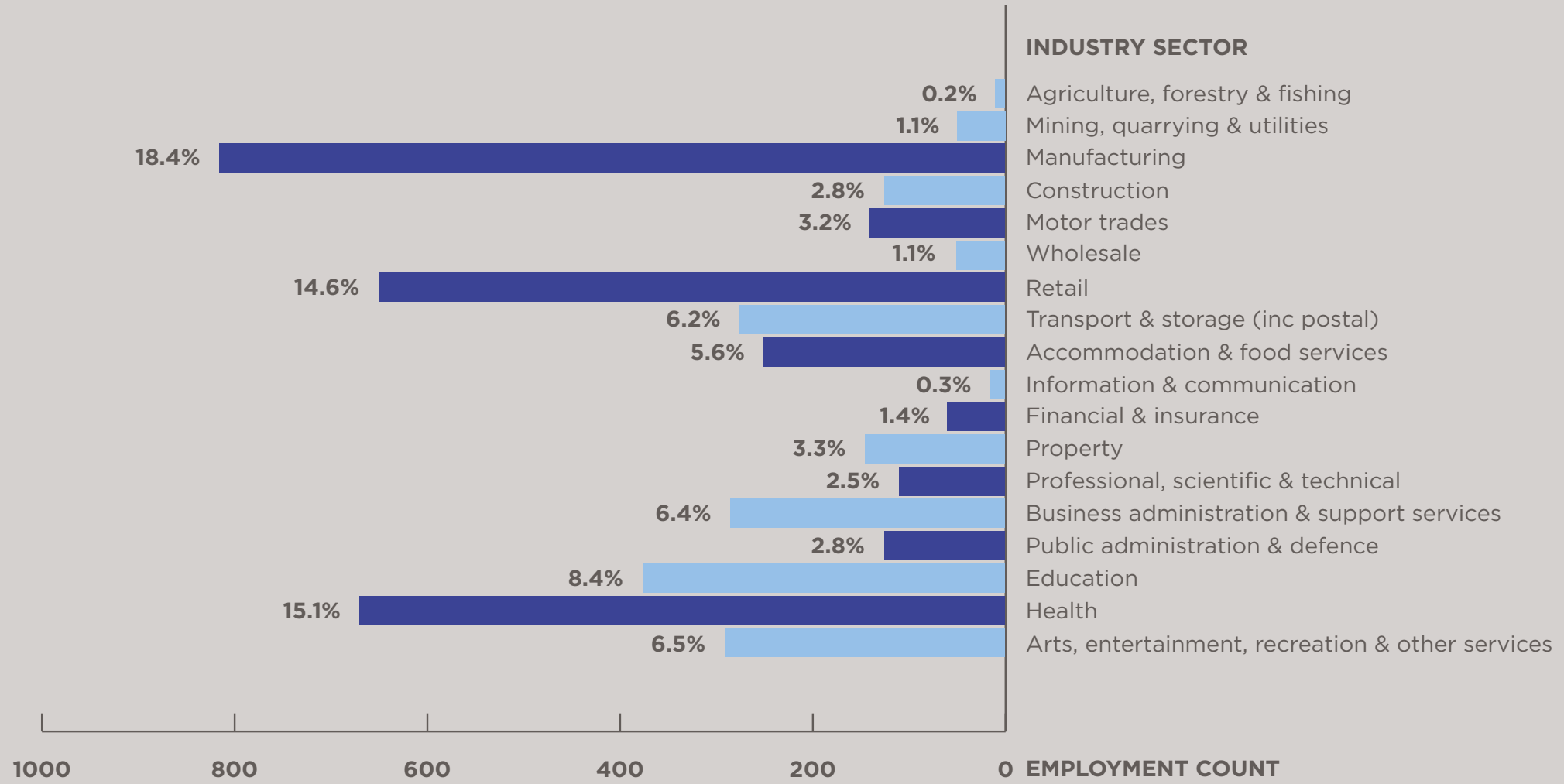

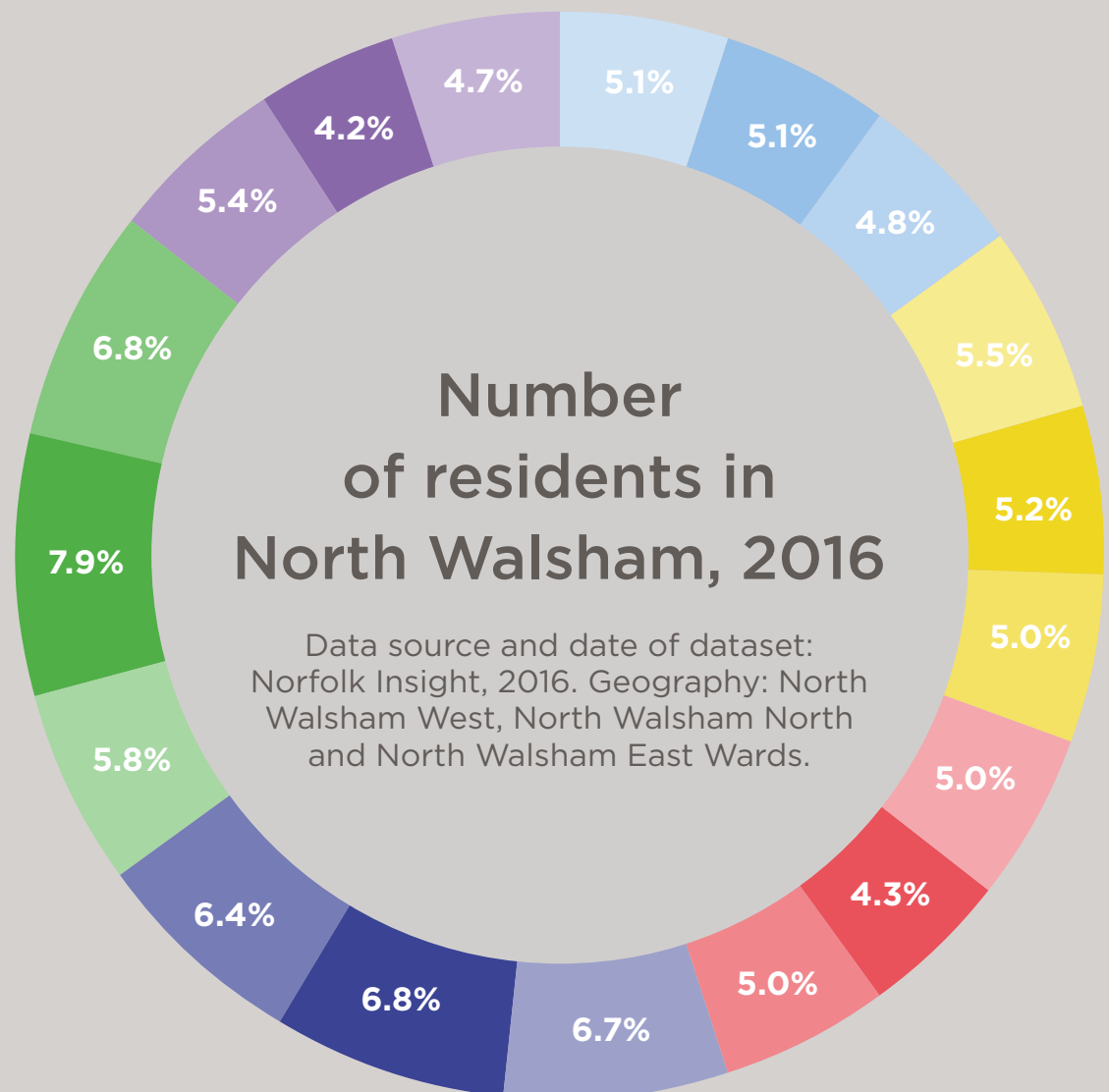

Number of residents in North Walsham, 2016

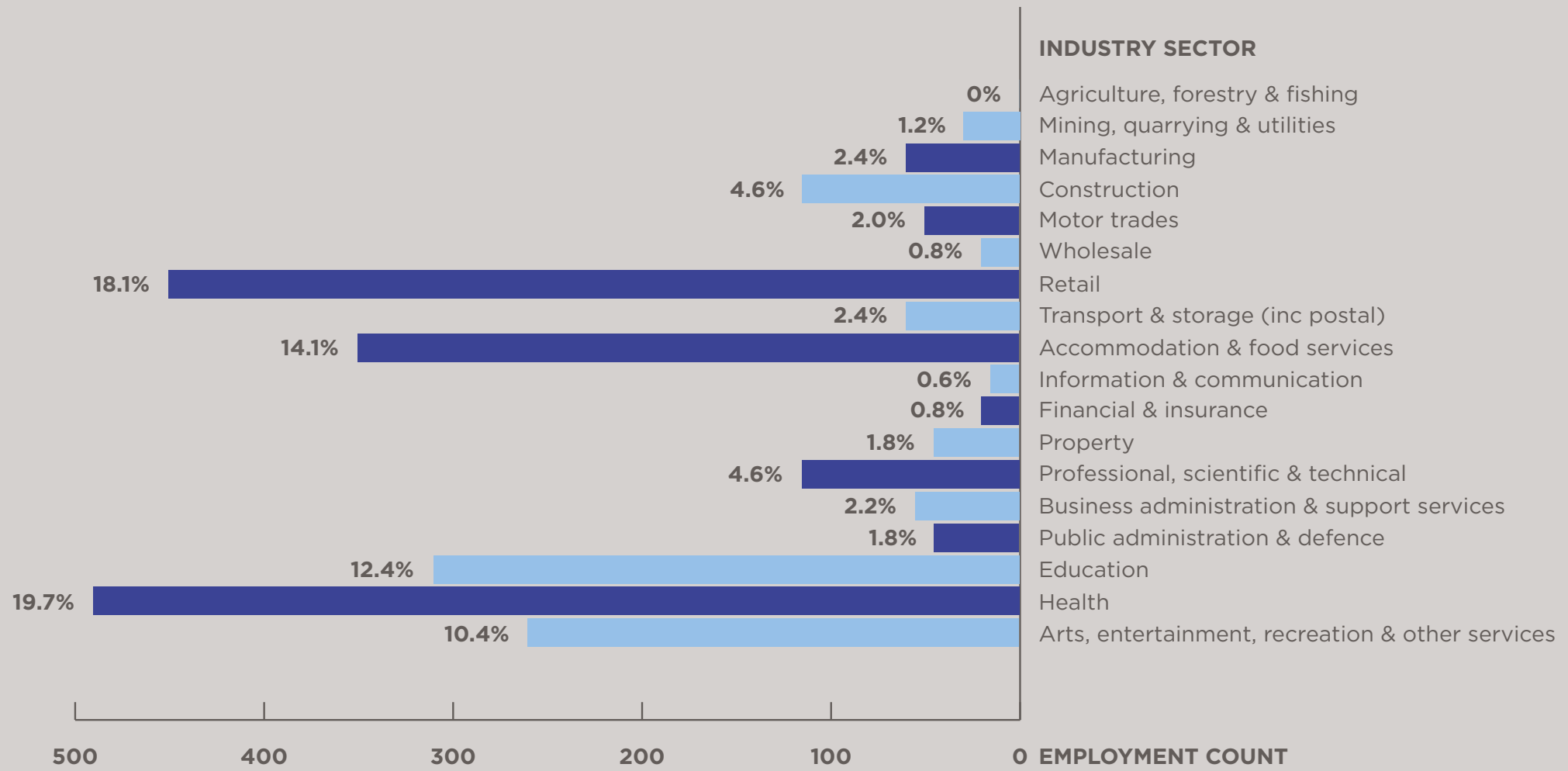

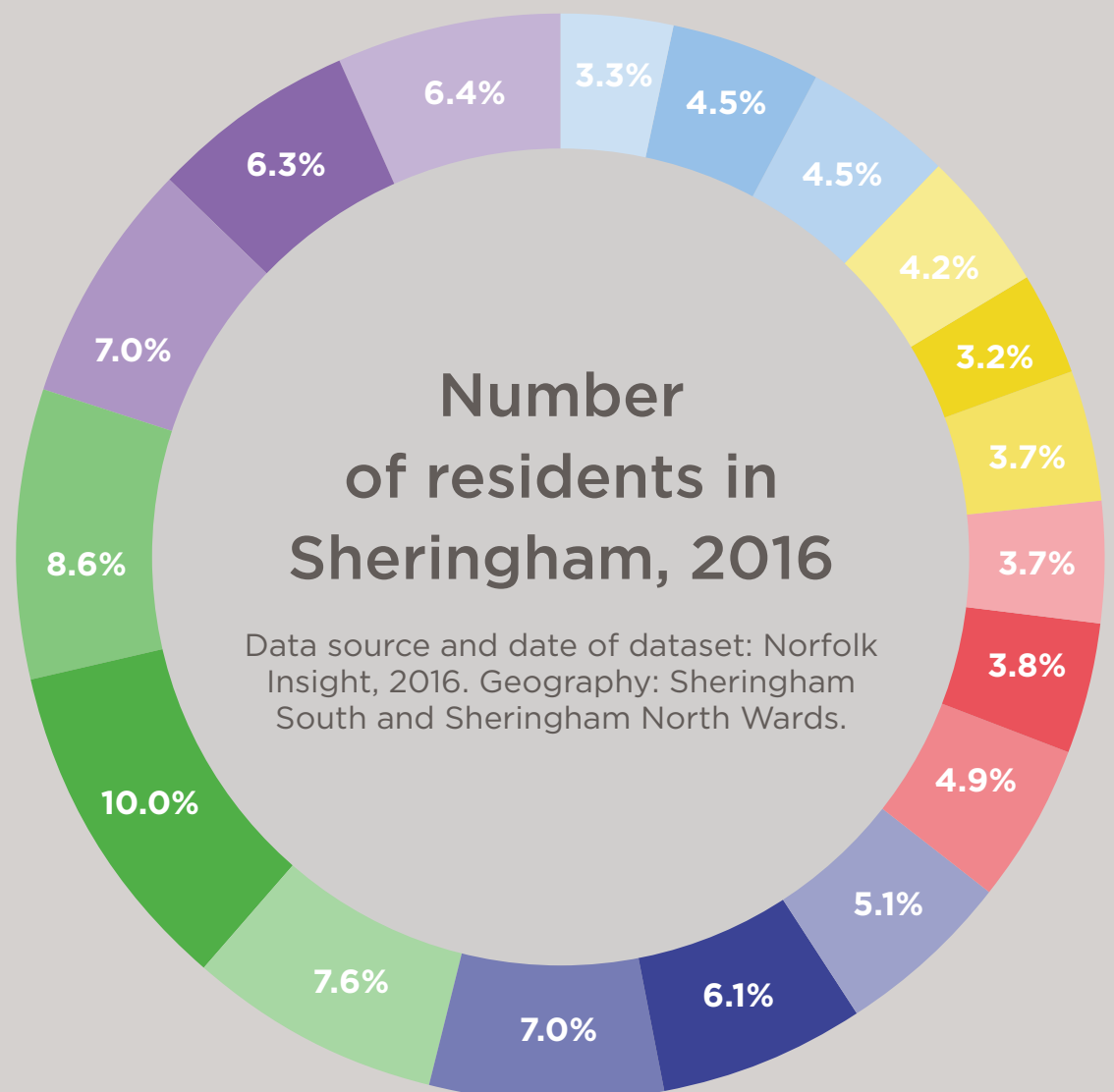

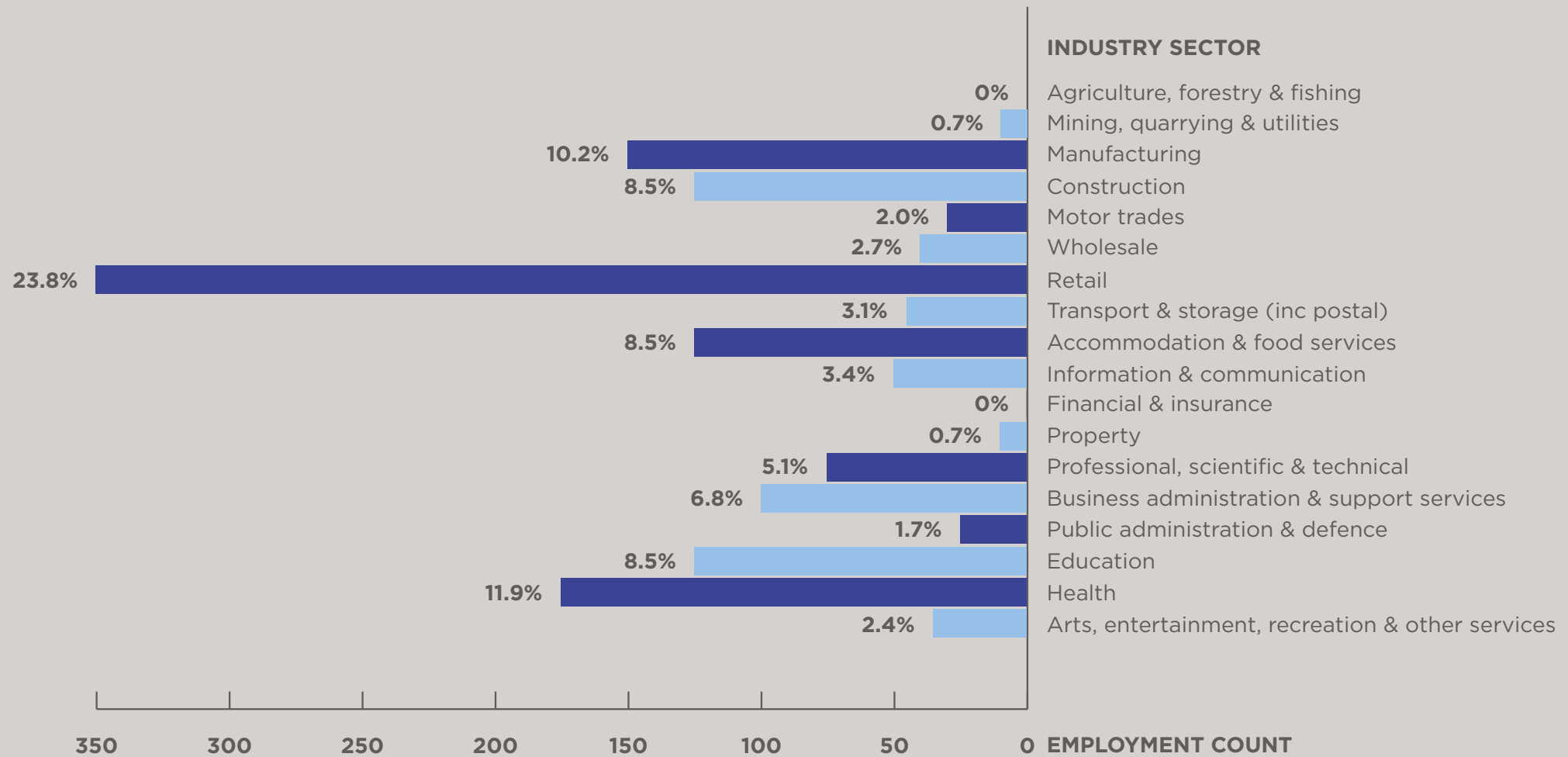

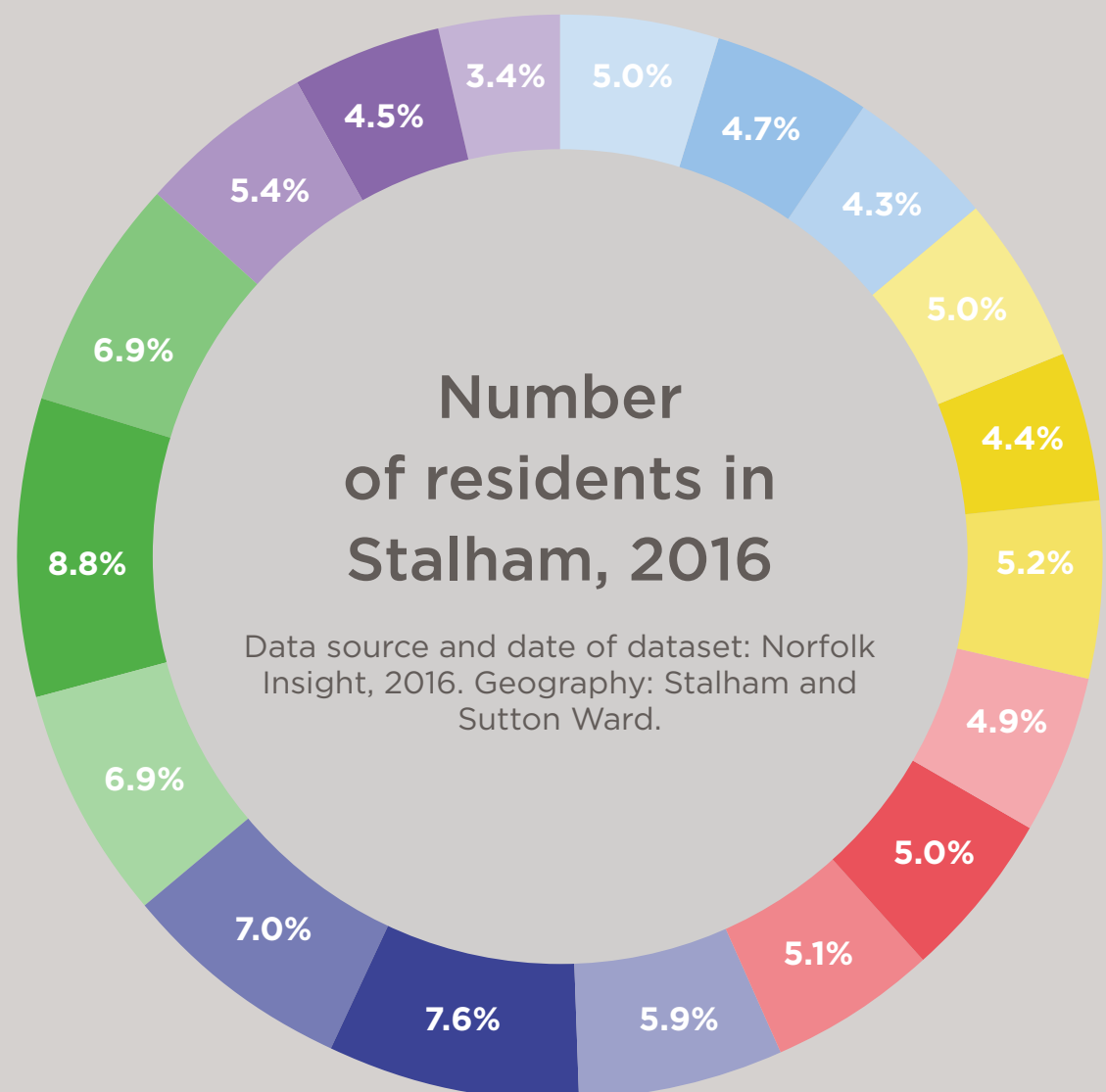

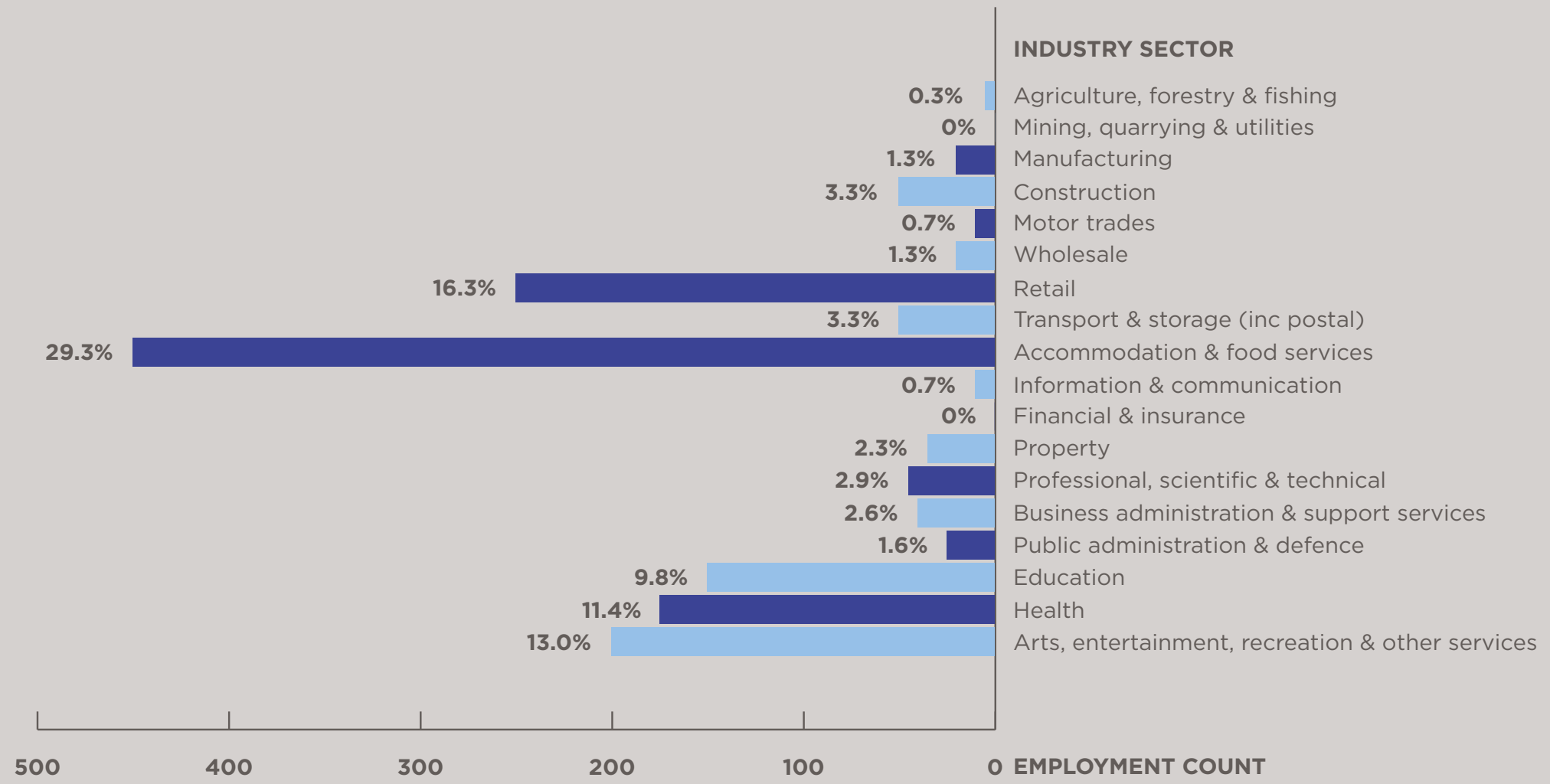

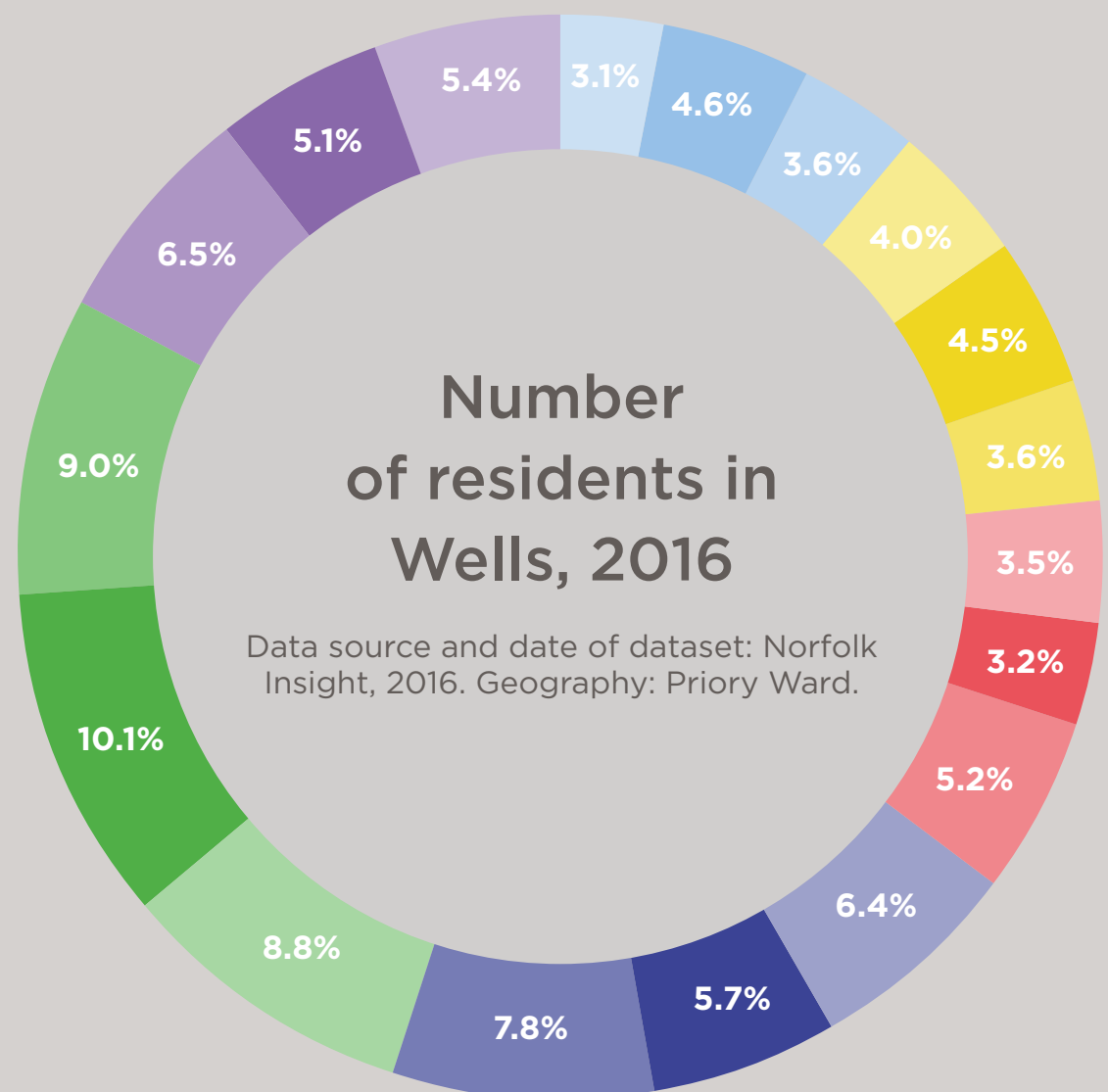

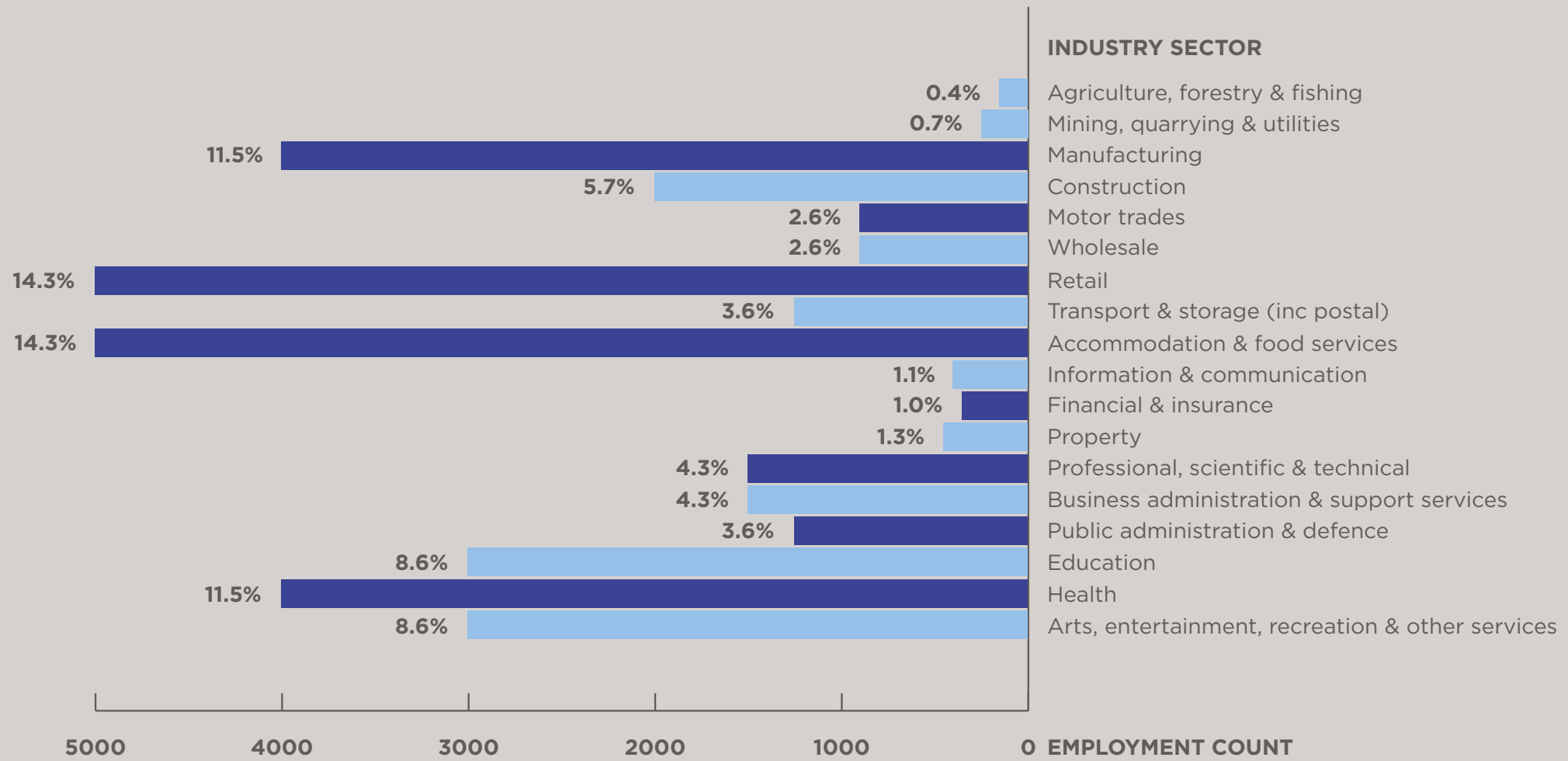

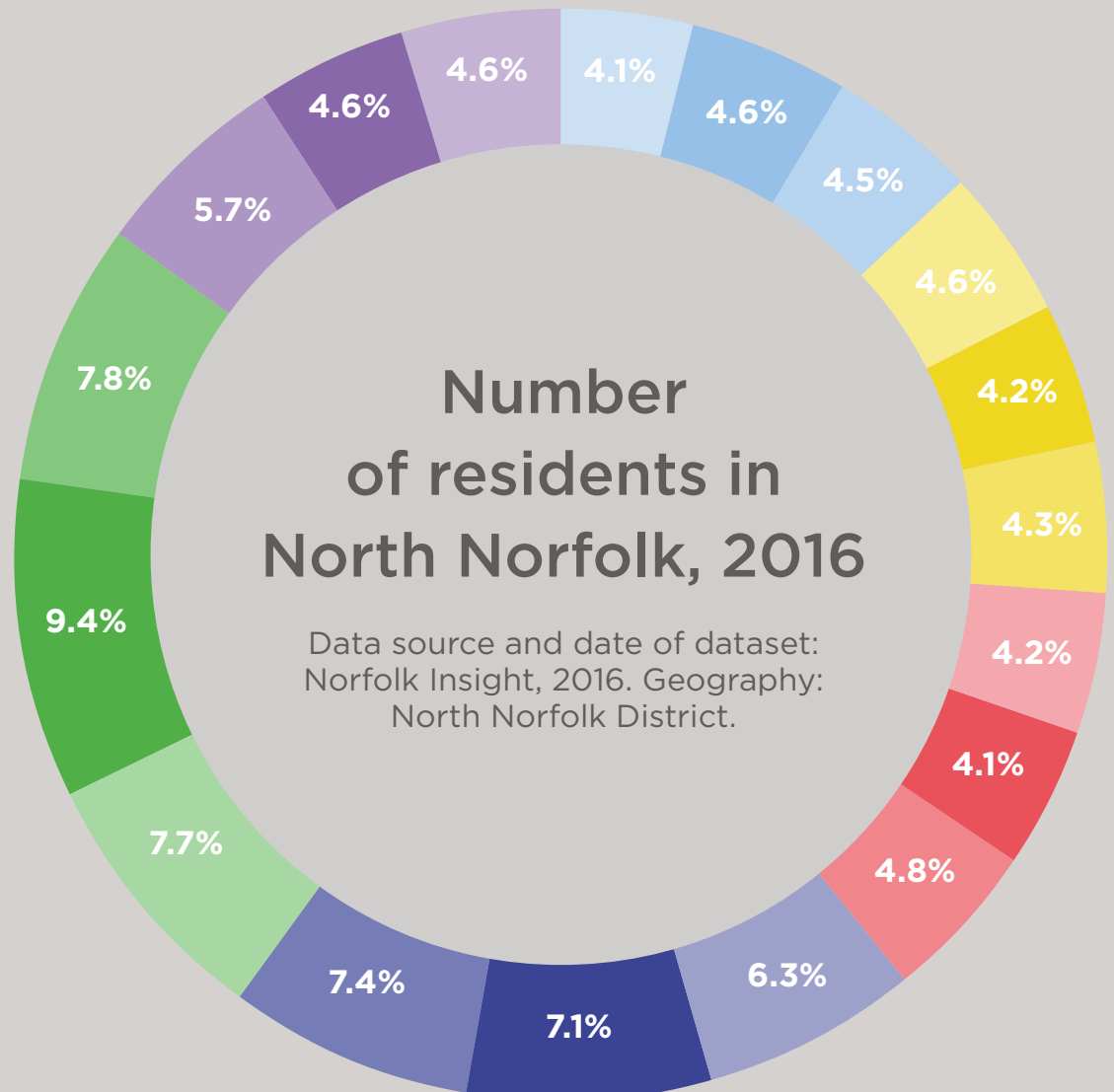
