

How can we help?

The Bacton to Walcott Sandscaping Scheme is placing 1.8 million cubic meters of sand on the beaches of Paston, Bacton and Walcott to protect the nationally important gas terminal and extend the life of the defences for the villages.

Team Van Oord, the contractors delivering the scheme, have provided North Norfolk District Council with £25,000 to distribute as community grants to parish councils and constituted groups in those villages. The company is also offering volunteer time from their team to assist with community projects.

No grants or projects are too small.

North Norfolk District Council is open to a wide variety of projects and will be looking to distribute funds based on the benefits they will bring to the community. Your group can apply for a grant, volunteer time or both. Volunteer time must be completed by mid-September.
