Under the Animal Welfare (Licensing of Activities Involving Animals) (England) Regulations 2018, businesses that intend to carry on the following licensable activities:

- Selling animals as pets in the course of a business;
- Providing or arranging for provision of accommodation for cats or dogs in the course of a business:
- Hiring out horses in the course of a business;
- Breeding 3 or more litters of puppies in any 12-month period; and/or breeding dogs and advertising a business of selling dogs; and
- Keeping or training animals for exhibition in the course of a business for educational or entertainment purposes

must be licensed by the applicable local council. These licences are known as 'Animal Welfare Licences'.

- 1. Legislation requires that licences are issued for a period of between 1 and 3 years, dependent on the outcome of the inspection of the premises and the star rating it is awarded.
- 2. Renewed licences will follow the same process.
- 3. Please complete Sections 1 to 16 of the application form, then select the relevant Schedule(s) for which your proposed licensable activity/activities apply
- 4. Should you need additional space to complete your response to these questions, please continue on an additional page, indicating clearly which question you are responding to. - 5. The licensing authority advises that an appropriate level of public liability insurance should be held by every business.
