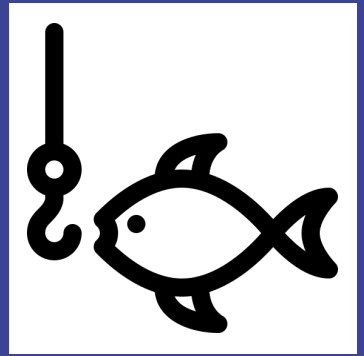


North Norfolk Fishing Guide



Coarse Fishing

Blickling Lake, near Aylsham

Set in the grounds of Blickling Hall, owned by the National Trust. This open water of over 20 acres is shallow and weedy at the hall end. Depths vary from 6ft to 10ft at dam wall end. No night fishing, no boilies, no pre-baiting, no live bait, no bait boats, no keep nets, no wading. Landing nets must be used for all fish. Barbless or micro barb hooks only. Max. two rods per person. Rods must be attended at all times. Fishing is from the stages or the wall only. Closed from 1 March to 30 June. Open 8am to sunset. Tickets on the bank from bailiff

This 2½ acre long and irregular shaped lake has two small islands. Depths vary from 3ft to 8ft. The water is always well coloured. Disabled access. Parking by most swims. Toilets available on Southerly Caravan Park. No keep nets or barbed hooks. Day tickets on bank - overnight and 24 hour fishing available by arrangement

Sea fishing and crabbing are popular activities on Cromer pier. There is a no-fish zone, indicated by signs, in the vicinity of the Lifeboat platform. Fishing is subject to the following code of conduct:
