- 2. We will check that the chosen property name is appropriate and that a duplicate name does not exist in the nearby area.
- 3. We will confirm your new address with you. If there is duplication or objection, we will contact you and ask you to choose another name.
- 4. We will inform Royal Mail, Ordnance Survey, Emergency Services, Openreach and Council's internal service
