### THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (HOLT, FISH HILL AND MARKET PLACE) (PEDESTRIAN ZONE AND LOADING BAY) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2023

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1) and (2), 9, 10 and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Holt, Fish Hill and Market Place) (Pedestrian Zone and Loading Bay) Experimental Order 2023 and shall come into operation for all purposes on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August 2023.
- 2. This Order shall remain in force for a period of 18 months.
- 3. <u>Modifications</u>

The person authorised to make modifications is to be the Executive Director of Community and Environmental Services or a person authorised by him.

4. In this Order –

Any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

"Civil Enforcement Officer" has the same meaning as in s76 of the 2004 Act;

"Class 1, Class 2 and Class 3 vehicles" have the same meaning as in Section 3 of The Use of Invalid Carriages on Highways Regulations 1988.

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2013; and

"Disabled Person's Vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"Driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in contravention of an Order, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left at that contravention;

"General Directions" shall mean The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016";

"General Regulations" shall mean The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022";

"Parking Disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No. 6571: 1997), but coloured blue and capable of showing the quarter hours period during which a period of waiting begins; and

for the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying

- (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when
  - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
  - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and
- (b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
- 5. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 6. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait along the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order except for the purposes of loading and unloading from 0800 hours to 1800 hours.
- 7. Nothing in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order shall prohibit a person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road or on the side of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
  - (a) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (b) building, industrial or demolition operations;
  - (c) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (d) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road or side of roads; or
  - (e) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said lengths of road or side of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in the Communications Act 2003;
  - (f) the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2011;
  - (g) in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (h) it is an unridden cycle;

- (i) is a Class 1, Class 2 or Class 3 vehicle.
- 8. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle owned by a funeral director or owner of funeral vehicles when in use as part of a funeral cortege.
- 9. Schedule 2 of The Norfolk County Council (Holt, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Consolidation and Variation Order 2012 is hereby suspended for the duration of this Order insofar as entries for the U14381/12 Fish Hill and U14380 Market Place relate to the lengths of roads set out in the Schedules to this Order.
- 10. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

#### SCHEDULE 1 In the Town of Holt

### Experimental Pedestrian Zone

U14381/12 Fish Hill	-	From the centreline of its junction with the C488/22 Market Place north-eastwards for a distance of 40 metres to the bollards where it meets U14381/20 Fish Hill.
U14380 Market Place	-	From the centreline of its junction with the C488/22 Market Place northwards to the centreline of its junction with U14375/30 Bull Street.

# In the Town of Holt

## Experimental Loading Bay: from 0800 hours to 1800 hours

C488/22 Market Place	From a point 87 metres east of the centreline its junction with U14379/10 Shirehall Plain to a point 97 metres east of the centreline its junction with U14379/10 Shirehall Plain on the north side of the
	carriageway.
