

NORTH NORFOLK DISTRICT COUNCILTOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL
DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1988
(S.I. 1988 No. 1813)DIRECTION RESTRICTING PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS the North Norfolk District Council (hereinafter called "the Council") being the appropriate Local Planning Authority within the meaning of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 (hereinafter called "the said Order") are satisfied that it is expedient that development described in the schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land at Cromer Road, Beeston Regis, Norfolk as shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application under the said Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1988.

AND WHEREAS the Council are of the opinion that development of the said land as described in the Schedule hereto would be prejudicial to the proper planning of the Council's area and would constitute a threat to the amenities of the said area.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article 4 of the said Order HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land as described in the Schedule hereto.

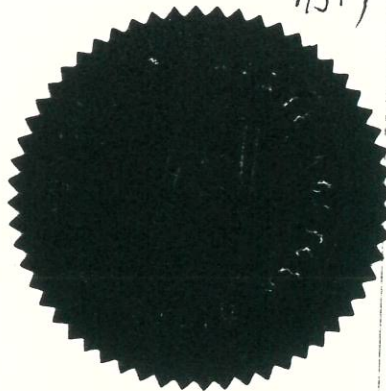
THIS DIRECTION is made in pursuance of the provisions of Article 5(5) of the said Order and shall remain in force until 7th October, 1989 (being six months from the date of this Direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date.

SCHEDULE

The use of the said land on not more than fourteen days in total in any calendar year for the purpose of the holding of markets and the provision on the said land of any moveable structure for the purpose of that use being development comprised within Part 4 Class B of Schedule 2 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 and not being development within any other Part or Class of Schedule 2 of the said Order.
