

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCILTOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1950.DIRECTION RESTRICTING PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT.

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter called "the Council") as Local Planning Authority and acting in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order for development of the class specified in Classes IV(2) and V of the First Schedule thereof (namely the temporary use of land and the use of land by members of recreational organisations) shall not apply to an area of land forming part of Ordnance Survey Parcel Nos. 274, 277, 266 Pt. Parcel Nos. 286, 279, 282, 280a (Norfolk Sheet XXX-II 1906 Second Edition) in the parish of Lessingham and county of Norfolk which land is shown on the plan annexed hereto and thereon edged red.

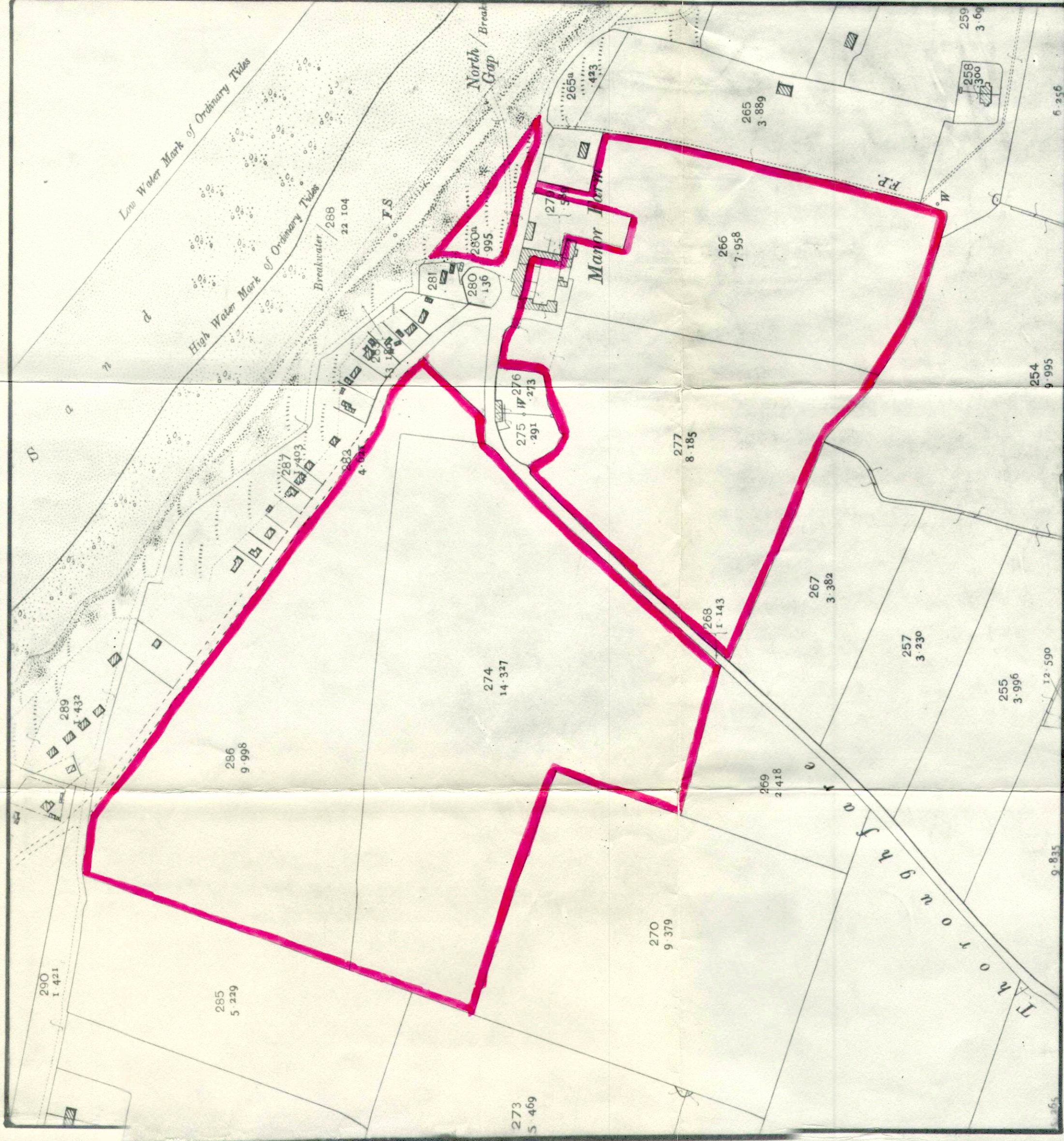
