DILHAM BRICKGROUND CONSERVATION AREA: (Designated 14/12/95)

The Conservation Area is situated on the western edge of the village of Dilham, Norfolk at the head of a branch of the Dilham canal.

The boundary runs west from the Honing Road along the northern boundary of field parcel 0145 which forms the southern boundary of the brickground. The boundary continues west for some 250 metres before turning north along the western boundary of the brickground. In some 70 metres the boundary joins the southern boundary of field parcel 0467 at which point it turns east following the field boundary of parcel 0467. The Conservation Area continues in an easterly direction 3 metres from the rear wall of the workers' cottages at the brickground. At the eastern corner of the workers' cottages the boundary turns south along the gable end of the cottages. From here it continues south east for some 30 metres in a curve and then east again following the southern boundary of field parcel 0467 and the northern boundary of the track leading from the Honing Road to the brickground. The boundary continues in an easterly direction along the southern boundary of the property known as No. 6 Honing Road. At the junction with the Honing Road the boundary turns south following the western parapet of the bridge before completing the boundary.
